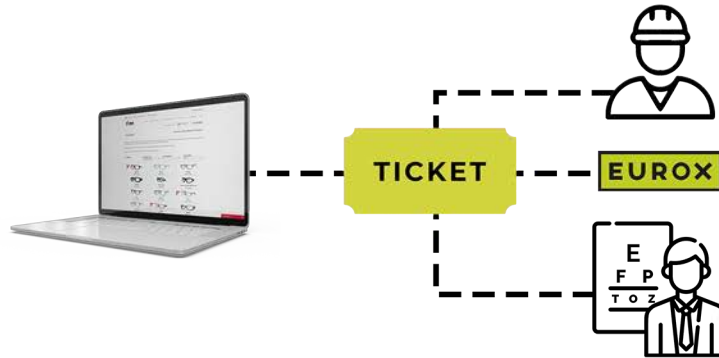

PROCEDURE FOR PURCHASING PRESCRIPTION GLASSES

STAGE 1

1. The MCR Safety portal allows Eurox customers/employees to order prescription safety eyewear. A ticket is created and shared with the employee, Eurox, and the opticians



2. Employees receive a text message urging them to visit their local optician for an eye test



3. Following an eye test, the employee is given a choice of frames from a predetermined list. Employees can also be advised whether they need single vision or bi-focal lenses. Additional requirements, such as tinted or hard coated lenses, can also be discussed. (Subject to customer approval).



PROCEDURE FOR PURCHASING PRESCRIPTION GLASSES

STAGE 2

1. The opticians complete and send an electronic form with the employee's requirements to MCR Safety

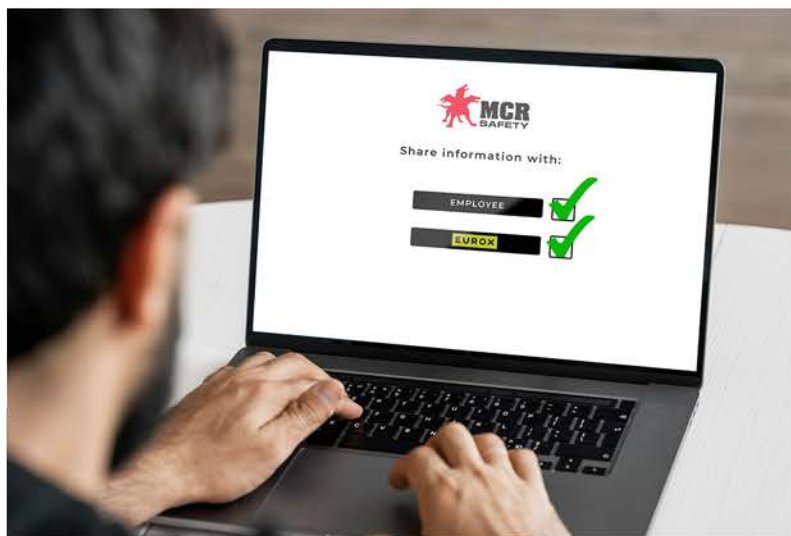

2. Upon receiving the information, MCR Safety shares it electronically with Eurox in real time.



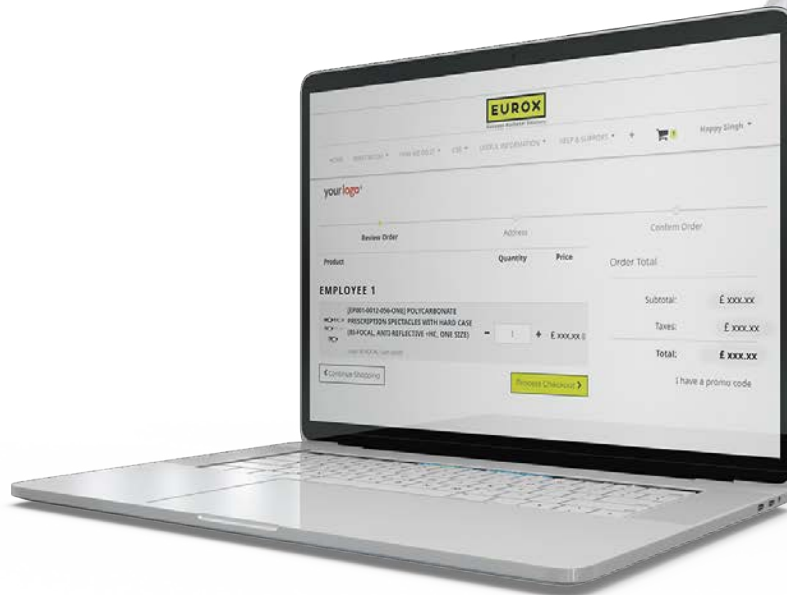
3. In order to create a PO, Eurox will notify the customer electronically to approve the PO on the Eurox ordering portal



PROCEDURE FOR PURCHASING PRESCRIPTION GLASSES

STAGE 3

1. Following receipt of a customer's purchase order, Eurox's back office will issue MCR a purchase order for the product to be manufactured. MCR will manufacture the safety eyewear within two days and despatch them to the opticians, notifying Eurox of the process.



2. Eurox will notify the employee, upon receipt of MCR Information, that the prescription safety glasses have been delivered to the opticians for fitting, allowing the employee to make an appointment with the opticians.

PROCEDURE FOR PURCHASING PRESCRIPTION GLASSES

STAGE 3 -CONTINUED

3. After the employee visits the optician, the optician ensures that the fitting is correct before providing the employee with their prescribed safety glasses.



4. Invoices will be sent to the customer after the employee is satisfied with the service provided. In addition, Eurox will store details about the employee's eye test on their database. An eye test reminder will be sent to the employee after two years.
